Nicomachean Ethics Terms

Nicomachean: (supposedly) edited by Aristotle's son Nicomachus

ethics: *ethike*, moral philosophy (compare: *ethikos*, showing moral character; *ethos*, character)

unfamiliar uses of terms

politics: politike, knowledge of government, but also knowledge of society

end: telos, purpose, aim

science: episteme, knowledge (for its own sake)

art, applied science: techne, craft, knowledge enabling production

timocracy: political system based on property qualification

Note: This is like Plato's "oligarchy," not like Plato's "timocracy."

Plato's "timocracy" is from timé (honor), but Aristotle's "timocracy" is from timeme (property qualification).
