in medias res (Latin): "into the middle of things"

nostos: "homecoming" kleos: "glory, fame"

proem: opening lines of poem, introducing main theme

xenia: "guest-host relationship"

xenos: "guest" or "host"

nekuia: visit to the Underworld (compare katabasis in the Aeneid) – name for Book 11

outis / metis : "nobody"

atasthalia: "recklessness" (of the suitors, of Odysseus's men)

homophrosyne: "likemindedness"

polytropos: "of twists and turns" (epithet for Odysseus, describing his journey, his wiles, his

storytelling)
