## MLA Paper Format

Indent each paragraph half an inch (use the Tab key). Format your paper in Times New Roman font, 12 point font size. Double-space your text, but you don't need additional spacing between paragraphs.

The margins on the page should be set to 1 inch on all sides (be careful; sometimes the default is 1.25 inches on left and right). Use a header in the top right corner that includes your last name and the page number (in Microsoft Word, use Insert: Page Numbers). Your title should be centered and in title case, but not italicized, underlined, or bold.

When citing a work with a listed author and with page numbers, use a parenthetical citation including the author's last name followed by the page number (Last-name 143). Use the same format for any work with a listed author, whether it is a book, part of a book, a journal article, or a webpage (Surname 23, Name 52). If a work has no listed author, use part of the title in the citation instead; if the work has no page numbers, omit a page number ("Title").

Your Works Cited list should appear on a new page at the end of the paper, labeled Works Cited. Each citation should be indented on every line except the first. Although URLs are optional, not required, for MLA webpage citations, please do include URLs to make it easier for you and your readers to find your online sources. For more details on MLA format, see the *Harbrace Handbook*, pages 257-311.

- Surname, First-name. "Title of Article." *Title of Journal*, vol. VolumeNumber, no. IssueNumber, Year, pp. Pages.
- "Title of Webpage without Listed Author." *Name of Website*. Sponsoring/Publishing Organization, Date Updated, URL. Date Accessed.
